



wild bird feed labeling workshop

1:00 - 4:00 p.m. November 6:

Are wild bird food labeling issues keeping you awake at night? Then you need the WBFI Wild Bird Food Labeling Workshop on November 6, 2012! You'll learn the answers to these guestions and many others:

Who regulates labeling of wild bird food?

Do I need to register labels, or is just a feed license required?

What is labeling, anyway? Is my web site exempt from labeling requirements? What about brochures, point-of purchase information, etc.?

Is a label needed on pallets, bulk shipments or shipping papers?

What must absolutely, positively be on the label, and just how accurate does it need to be?

Can I get a little "creative" with my product name?

What non-required information can I add to the label, and is it regulated too?

Are human allergen statements required on wild bird food?

What about multi-packs, combo-packs and variety packs? Do they need separate labels?

Do revisions to an existing label make it into a new product?

Does the Food Safety Modernization Act contain new label requirements?

Is any regulatory agency going to analyze my product to see if the actual weight, ingredients and/or guaranteed analysis match my label? (No wonder I can't sleep!)



Aboard the Palm Springs Aerial Tramway, the world's largest rotating tramcar, you will experience a breathtaking journey up the sheer cliffs of Chino Canyon. Begin the 10 minute ride at the Valley Station – elevation 2,643 ft. and end at the Mountain Station – elevation 8,516 ft. No matter what the season, you will enjoy spectacular views on this one-of-a-kind experience.

Our WBFI group of 15 people minimum will take advantage of the Tram's Lunch 'n Dine. Your price for this day trip includes transportation to and from the Tram, round-trip Tram ride and lunch at the Pines Café, a cafeteria-style restaurant. The Palm Springs Air Museum is dedicated to the preservation, presentation and interpretation of the air power of World War Two and Korea. Trip Advisor ranks the Air Museum #3 out of 67 things to do in Palm Springs. One comment from Trip Advisor reads: The collection of aircraft is very impressive and the volunteers are on hand to answer any questions you may have. Be sure to take the walk through the flying fortress.

The Buddy Rodgers Theater shows Daily Documentaries about aviation in the military with a special emphasis on World War Two. In addition to airplanes and many artifacts and other historical pieces, the museum contains a library with over 6200 volumes relating primarily to aviation and American military history.

There are extensive museum displays and documentary films. There are often exhibition flights. Visitors can participate in the sights and sounds that have made history.
